



Clothing, Equipment and Footwear Policy

Clothing Policy

All teams participating in the NSW Youth Championships are expected to wear coloured clothing. All coloured clothing must be approved prior to playing by the Youth Championships Officer. If this is not possible, white/cream playing pants and a coloured playing shirt will be acceptable with submitted reason. Batting pads may be either white, cream or covered in coloured batting clads.

Sponsors Logos

Club and sponsors logos may be displayed on the front or back of playing shirts up to 100cm square in area respectively and/or on the sleeves of the playing shirts. Players are only permitted to wear the cap of the Club/Association/Zone they are representing, or alternatively, a white cricket hat.

Footwear

2.1 Attention is drawn to the requirements of some ground authorities that do not permit the use of non-spiked footwear on turf wickets. Visiting teams are advised to contact Home Teams to ascertain footwear restrictions. No spiked footwear can be worn during any matches played on synthetic pitches.
